New York City Hearings – April 20, 1972. Recording continues General Counsel Arthur Liman's examination of Louis R. James, District Attorney of Wyoming County, New York. James details his experiences with negotiations and inmate demands. Follow-up questions are asked by Commission members McKay, Henix, and Wilbanks. WRVR journalists Dan Mack and Adam Hanson summarize the session.
