


E. Daniel Williams biography

Private 1st class, Co. C, 306th Machine Gun Battalion, 27th Division, A.E.F.
June 18, 1916, enlisted.
National guard, federalized, July, 1917.
Shell shocked, returned to U.S. in Nov., 1918.
Apr. 4, 1919, died in hospital at Fort Sheridan, Ill., as a result of shell shock.

Short biography of Private First Class E. Daniel Williams, who enlisted into the National Guard on June 18, 1916. He died on April 4, 1919 in a hospital at Fort Sheridan as a result of shell shock.
