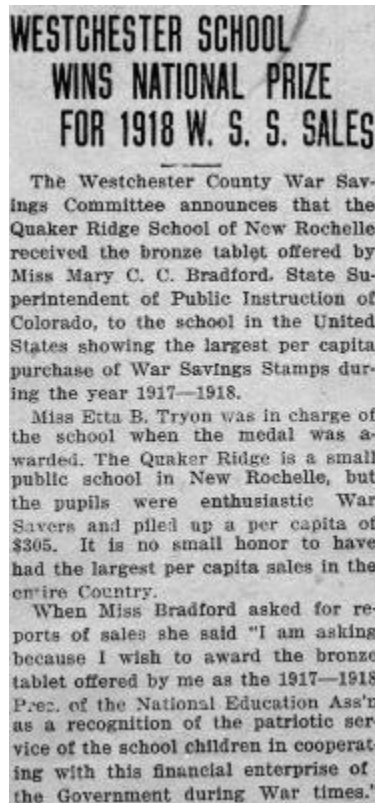


"Westchester School Wins National Prize for 1918 W. S. S. Sales"
