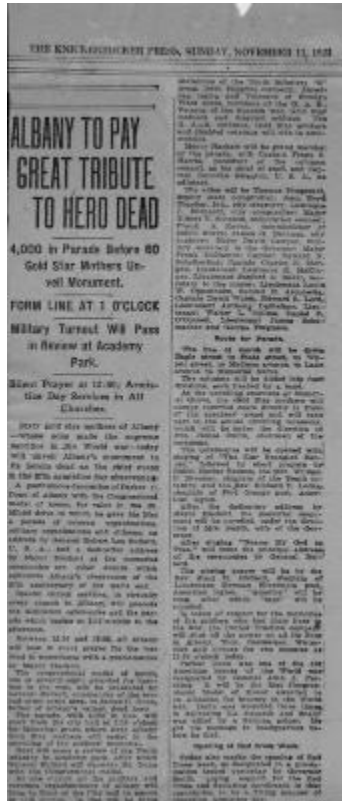


"Albany to Pay Great Tribute to Hero Dead"
