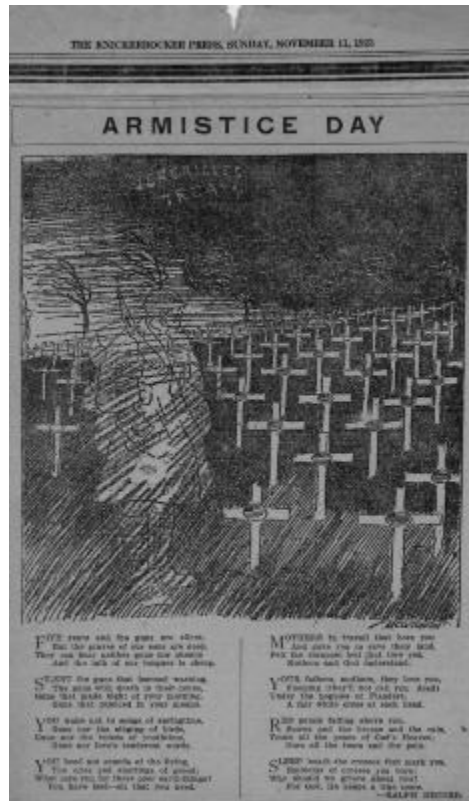


"Armistice Day"



A political cartoon and poem featured in the Knickerbocker Press on November 11, 1923.
