Appointment of Cornelis van Tienhoven to be provincial secretary; Hendrick Pietersen to be master mason; Hendrick Gerritsen, Peter Petersen and Lourens Laurensen, company's servants; Claes van Elsland, commissary; Jan Jansen, gunner in fort Amsterdam; Jan Dircksen, assistant gunner; Tomas Walraven, carpenter; Jacob Stoffelsen, overseer; Jan Petersen, barber at the south; Adriaen Dircksen, assistant commissary at Fort Orange; Dirck Stipel, quartermaster at Fort Orange; Gillis Pietersen, master carpenter; Nicolas Koorn, drill serjeant, and Jurian Rudolff, serjeant. (cont'd) [1638]; Court proceedings. Cors Pietersen vs. Adam Roelantsen, for recovery of his wife's share of her deceased mother's estate; judgment for plaintiff. [1638]; Order that Jan Schepmoes entertain no more sailors nor tap wine hereafter on pain of banishment. [1638]; Court proceedings. Wolphert Gerritsen vs. Jan Evertsen. Cornelis Lambertsen Cool vs. Cornelis and Jan van Vorst, in an action of debt. [1638]; Order granting freemen patents for the lands they are cultivating, on condition that at the end of ten years they pay yearly the tenth of all their crops, and also a couple of capons yearly for house and garden. [1638]
