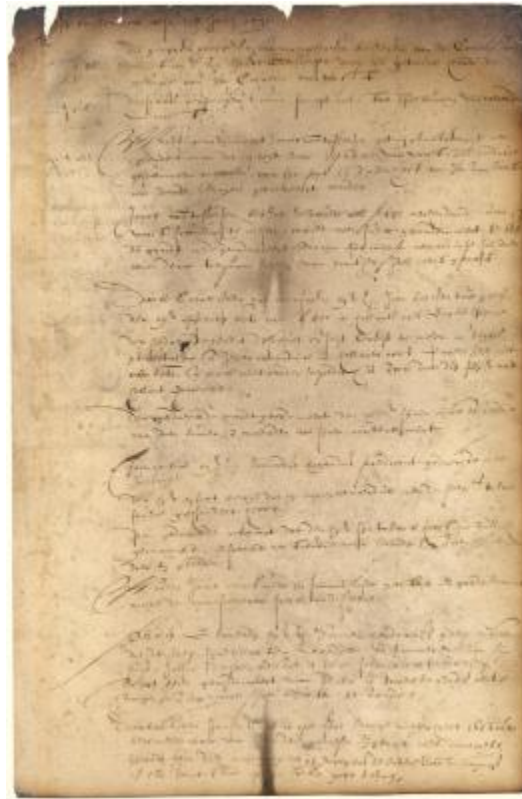


Dutch colonial council minutes, 13 June 1641



Court proceedings. The guardians of Cornelis van Vorst's children vs. Jacob Stoffelsen, husband of said Van Vorst's widow ; plaintiffs claim the corn growing on said Van Vorst's bouwery ; defendant ordered to prove that Hendrick van Vorst made the widow a present of his share, &c., and to pay 420 guilders, which he acknowledges to be indebted. Dirck Cornelissen vs. Jan Evertsen Bout ; action of debt ; judgment for plaintiff. Thomas Hall vs. rev. Everardus Bogardus, slander, defendant having accused the plaintiff with having rendered his tobacco unsaleable ; referred to arbitration. Philip Geraerdy vs. Juriaen Hendricksen, to oblige defendant to build a house for plaintiff according to contract ; judgment for plaintiff. [1641];Minute, allowing Bastiaen Jansen Crol certain fees for having seized a quantity of beaver skins at Fort Orange. [1641]
