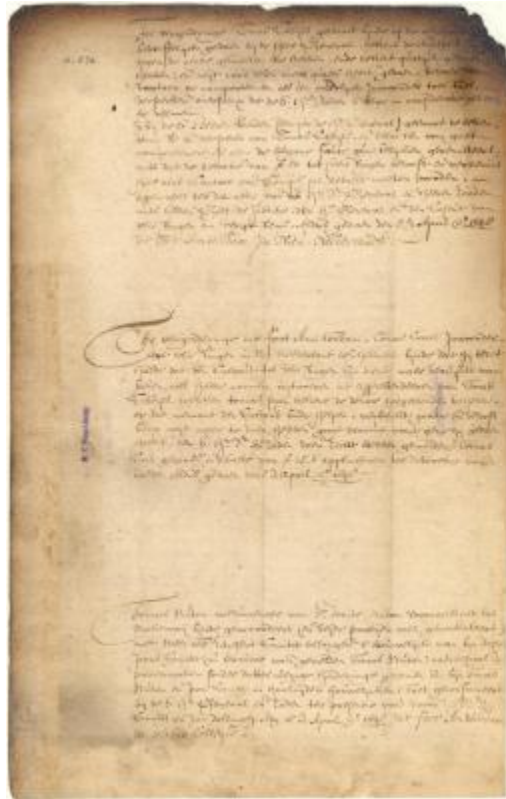


## Dutch colonial council minutes, 8-16 April 1648



Sentence. Thomas Steyls for an assault on sheriff Harck, fined 50 guilders, and to beg pardon of God, the court, the director-general and the sheriff. [1648]; Sentence. Thomas Saal, for obstructing sheriff Harck in the execution of his office, fined 25 guilders. [1648]; Marriage of Thomas Nuton, of Onckeway, and Joan Smith. [1648]
