

Dutch colonial council minutes, 6-12 October 1648



Sentence. Jan Teunisen, for slandering Harry Breser, an Englishman, and running away, taking with him the company's ferry boat, to work 100 days for the company, and 50 for the church, and to give bail for the faithful performance of his work. [1648]; Ordinance. Against harboring persons bound to serve the company or private persons. [1648]
