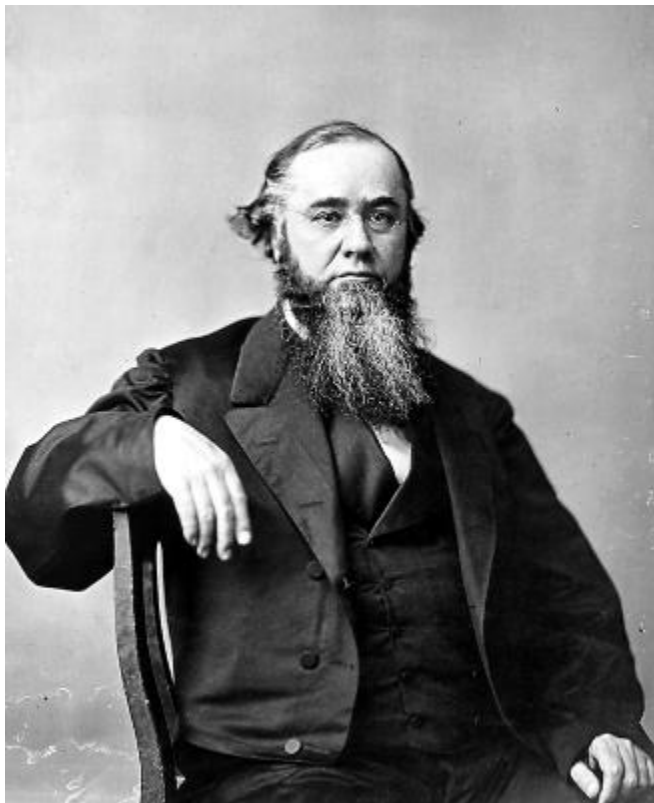


## Civil War. Portrait of Edwin M. Stanton seated
