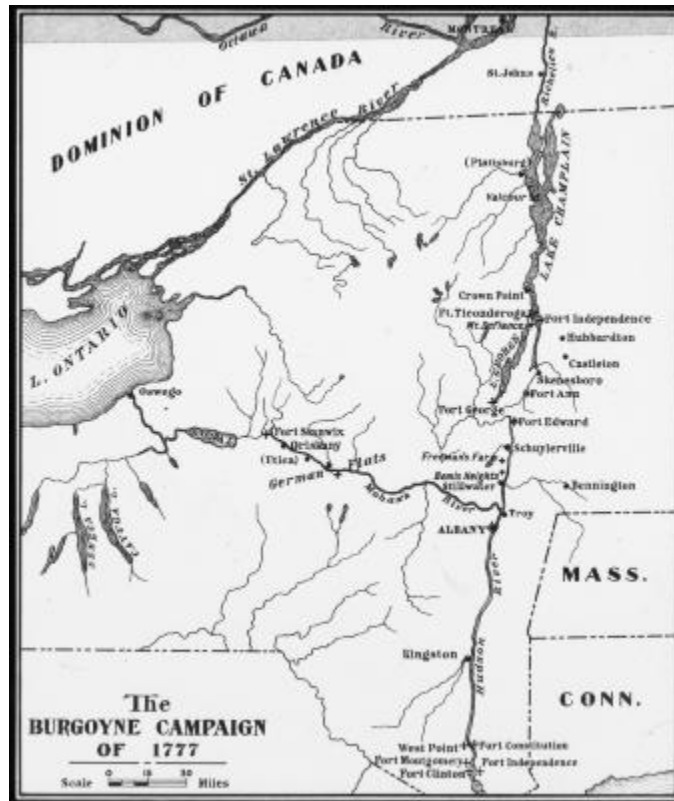


American Revolution. Map of Burgoyne Campaign of 1777
