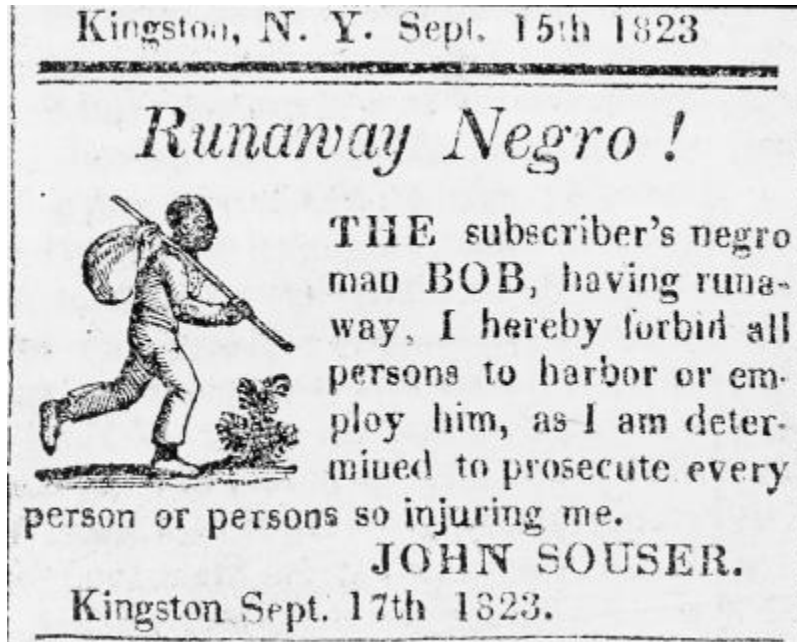


## Civil War. Advertisement of a Run-A-Way Negro
