

## Receipt for Canajoharie and Catskill Railroad stock

Received Catskill Nov. 6<sup>th</sup> 1835 from John A. Thomson  
one hundred <sup>five</sup> ~~thirty~~ Dollars which is five per cent on Fifty shares  
of the Canajoharie and Catskill Rail road Stock, to be transferred when  
twenty-five per cent is paid thereon. *Donnelly Cornwall Amick*  
\$125.00 *for Peter D. Mesick*

Receipt for shares purchased by John A. Thomson in the Canajoharie and Catskill Railroad. The Railroad was chartered in 1828 as the Catskill & Ithaca Railroad and was to run inland from the village of Catskill toward Ithaca, but reached only as far as Cooksburg. The line was abandoned in 1842 and scrapped.
