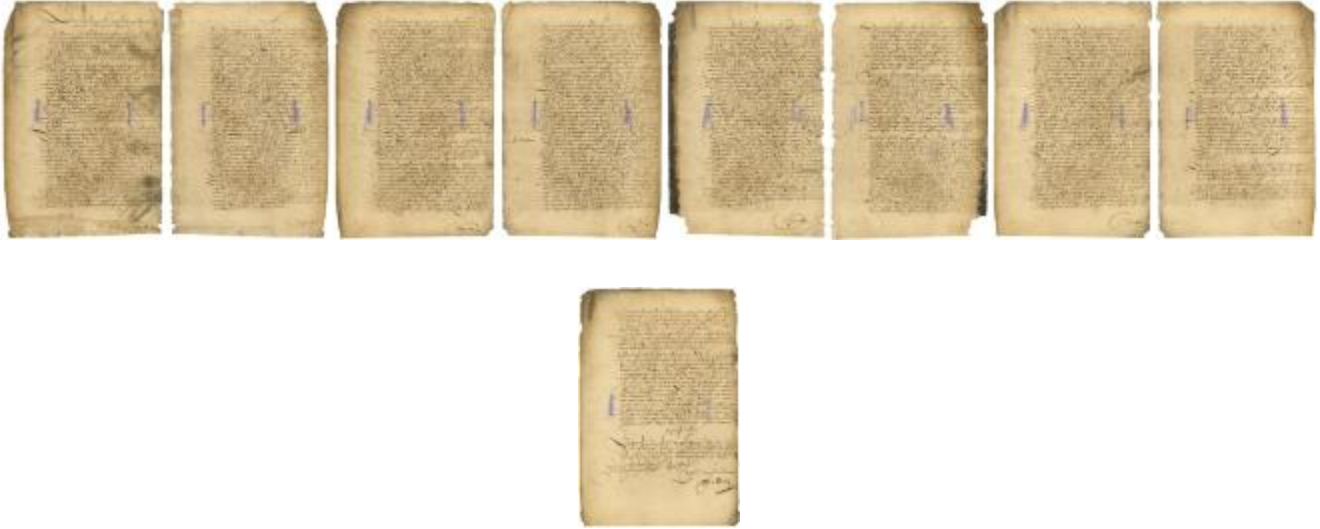


LETTER from Matthias Beck, vice-director of Curaçao to the directors in Amsterdam
