John Scott, and so westerly along the said river till it comes to a certain hill called by ye Indians Kanendenra otherways by the Christians Anthony's noos, and so up into the woods to the foot of said hill, and likewise southerly so far up into ye woods along ye bounds of ye said John Scott till it contains ye quantity of 8,000 acres of land.
