IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SENATE RULES, IN ORDER TO REGISTER COLLEGE AND

AND REPORTS OF MISSING STUDENTS OCCURRING ON CAMPUS, AND
TO AMEND THE SENATE BILL IN RELATION TO REGISTERING THE LISTING OF
CAMPUS SECURITY SERVICES TO OPERATE A TELEPHONE, AND THE
