AN ACT to amend the social services law, the family court act and the domestic relations law, in relation to encouraging efforts to prevent foster care placement or to enable a foster child to return home; the conducting of emergency hearings for children in foster care; the review of criminal background records of prospective foster and adoptive parents and procedures to be followed by the courts, such proceedings, and making an appropriation therefor
