Bill amended, ordered reported as amended and committed to said committee.

AN ACT to amend the social services law, the family court act and the domestic relations law, in relation to amendments efforts to prevent foster care placement or to make a foster child or youth home; the amending of emergency funding for children in foster care; the revoking of criminal background checks of prospective foster and adoptive parents and procedural rights for certain persons in foster care proceedings; and making an appropriation therefor.
