
Historical Map of Asia Minor about 1086, Showing Kingdom of Iconium



Historical map of Asia Minor about 1086, showing the kingdom of Iconium, Cyprus, the kingdom of Jerusalem, and the Eastern Roman (Byzantine) Empire. From George P. Fisher's outlines of Universal History. This is a map of the Middle East as it was a decade before the beginning of the first Crusade. Asia Minor was divided, with the Byzantine Empire controlling the western section and the Seljuk Turks controlling the eastern section. This eastern section was called the Kingdom of Iconium, (1916).

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
