IN SENATE -- A RESIST BILL, submitted by the Governor pursuant to article III, section 3 of the Constitution -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Finance -- Committee discharged. Bill amended, ordered reported as amended and recommitted to said committee.

IN ASSEMBLY -- A RESIST BILL, submitted pursuant to article III, section 3 of the Constitution -- read twice and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means -- Committee discharged. Bill amended, ordered reported as amended and recommitted to said committee.

AN ACT to amend chapter 424 of the laws of 1998 amending the education law and other laws relating to rates for residential health care facilities, in relation to pharmacy supplies, in relation to multi-trial payments to certain facilities, to amend chapter 19 of the laws of 1998, amending the social services law relating to limiting the method of payment for prescription drugs under the medical assistance program, in relation to the effectiveness of such chapter, to amend the social services law, in relation to state reimbursement to acute chapter 421 of the laws of 1997 amending the public health law and other laws relating to rates of reimbursement paid to hospitals and ambulatory health care facilities in relation to normal care rates by social services districts; one to amend the public health law and chapter 1 of the laws of 1999, amending the public health law and other laws relating to amending the New York Health Care Reform Act of 1996, in relation to funds deposited in the tobacco control and insurance initiatives trust; and to amend chapter 424 of the laws of 1998, amending the public health law, the service program law and the social services law relating to authorizing the establishment of special needs plans, chapter 196 of the laws of 1998, amending the social services law and the education law relating to medical assistance, ALL SECTIONS OF SUCH LAWS AND AMENDMENTS TO SUCH LAWS, AND
