SEN 802 is added to chapter 70 of the laws of 2000, entitled "an act to amend
the constitution, to be entitled in sense and substance as follows:
SECTION 1. The judicial branch of government shall consist of the
judicial officers and employees of the judicial branch,
including the judicial branch personnel as well as judicial officers and
employees of the judicial branch, in relation to their employment
or appointment, or removal, resignation, discipline and discipline of the
judicial branch system and holding of judicial office."
