AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to prioritizing the purchasing of remanufactured commodities through the state procurement process; to amend the state finance law and the general municipal law, in relation to permitting libraries, library systems, cooperative library systems and various library associations, to make purchases through the Office of General Services computerized database; to amend chapter 92 of the laws of 1993 amending the state finance law and other laws relating to expanding the use of arts involving loan funds, to release an amending certain provisions of the state finance law to amend the state finance law and the economic development law, in relation to increasing services and commodities to export organizations; to amend section 105 of the state finance law relating to the social impact on the benefits of purchasing institutions to support certain items of the state finance law relating to protected service status for New York state labeling wines; to amend the state finance law, in relation to favored status status for New York state labeling wines and to amend the state financial law and the public lands law, in relation to the sale of unappropriated state lands; and providing for the repeal of certain provisions upon expiration thereof
