AN ACT to amend chapter 729 of the laws of 1994 relating to affecting the health insurance benefits and contributions of retired employees of school districts and certain boards, in relation to the effectiveness of such chapter.

Dear Governor Pataki:

The above-referenced bill is now before you for executive action.

This bill would require that between June 30, 1995 and May 31, 1997, certain school districts and boards could not diminish the level of health insurance benefits provided to retirees and their dependents or the contributions made for such benefits without imposing a corresponding diminution of the benefits or contributions for the corresponding group of active employees for said retirees. [The bill is purely an extension of the time period for the applicability of virtually identical bill passed in 1994.]

The legislation would again essentially require public employers to maintain current benefit/contribution levels for retirees by linking them to the levels of those benefits/contributions provided to related active employees for the stated period. As benefit levels for
