To his Excellency George Clinton Esquire Governor
of the State of New York.

I do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the Legislature
entitled "An Act to encourage the settlement of the
waste and unappropriated Lands within this State
passed the seven Day of May last, for my self and my
associates produce one Claim to the Lands lawfully
purchased of the Indian Nations, which have not
been patented, and are particularly described and
described in their Book of Conveyance heretofore
announced.
