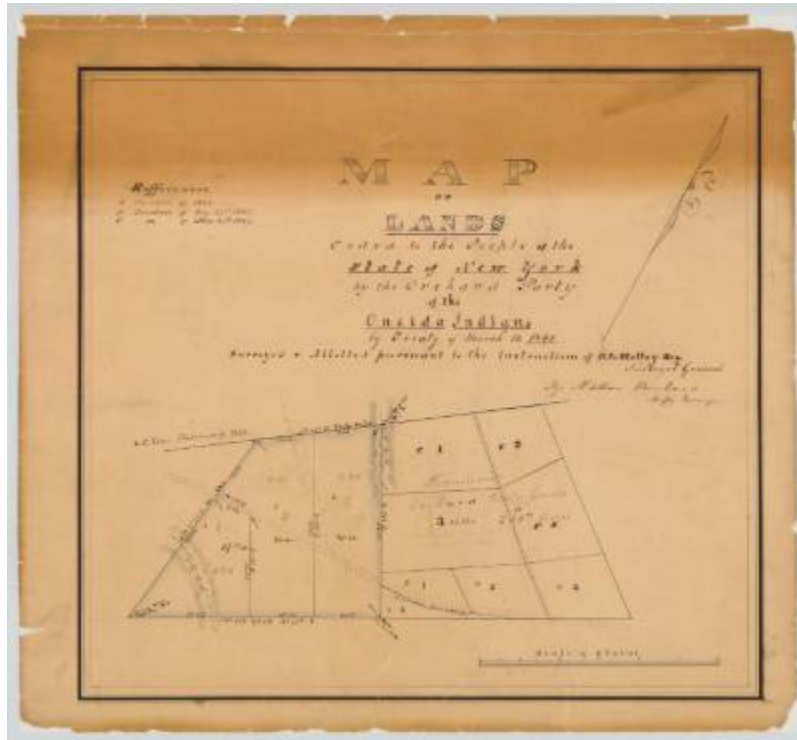


Map of the lands ceded to the people of the State of New York by the Orchard Party of the Oneida Indians by treaty of March 13, 1841
