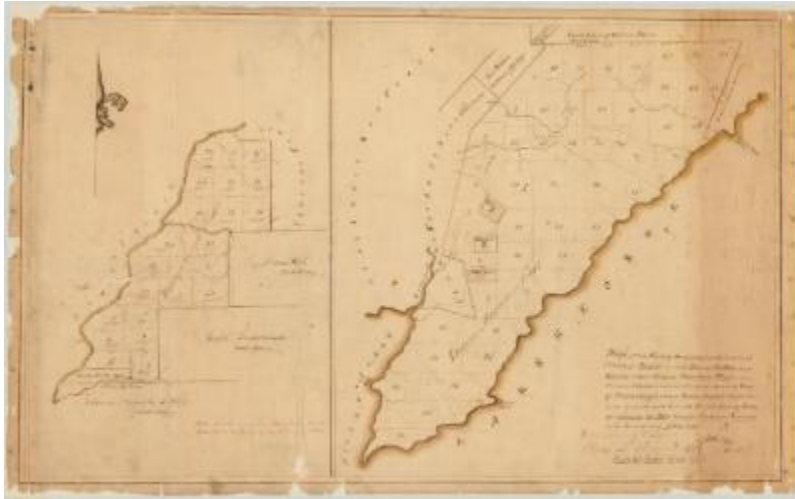


Map of two tracts of unappropriated land in the county of Warren. Map #5
