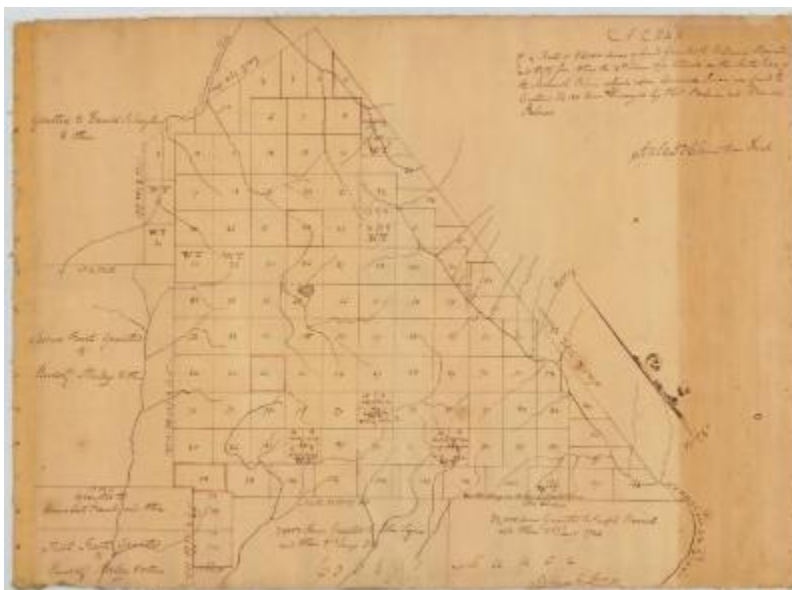


## Map of tract of 56,000 acres of land, granted to W. M. Bayard and 54 others. Map #139
