Even the sum beamed as the 400 happy children murched provely down the school steps to the side walk. The drummer"boy"headed the procession a hugo brown fur muff on her bead, held in place by a red bund under her ohim. Her drum was beatem in perfect time.

"GBGLE SAR", the tallest girl, was accompanied by "LIBERTY" on one side and a dainty little RED GROSS nurse on the other.

Three American Indians, fine in war paint (colored chalk) and feethered head dress( made by the children themaylres) followed with dignity.

The mine divisions were all dressed in white. Each division wore either red ,white or blue ribbons. Some classes had epaulettes and others mashes of our mational colors.

The limof march was thru the meighborhood streets, cicling the school block twice. The children many simple patrictic airs as they marched.

In front of the school, the parade same to a halt and at a signal 2 faced the entrance, where stood members of the school staff. 88 pupils held aloft the national flags at the head of the school stops.

Every one soluted the flag and even the an-lookers joined in singing "ANNERION".

So ended a happy experience for these little people, and in days to dome they may tell of "Nother's First Parade".
