View of about two dozen men who appear to be planting trees at Lake Clear Junction in Harrietstown, Franklin County in the Adirondack Mountains. The date is unknown, but the men's clothing suggests ca. 1900-1910. This image was likely created to record the reforestation activities of the New York State Forest, Fish and Game Commission.
