

New York Games laws; Caught in the Quagmire (cartoon)



View of an editorial cartoon commenting on New York State's hunting regulations. The cartoon depicts two hunters symbolizing the Herkimer County townships of Wilmurt and Salisbury in the Adirondack Mountains. The town of Wilmurt was divided into the present-day townships of Ohio and Webb in 1896; thus this cartoon dates from then at the latest. This image was likely created to record the game-related activities of the New York State Forest, Fish and Game Commission.
