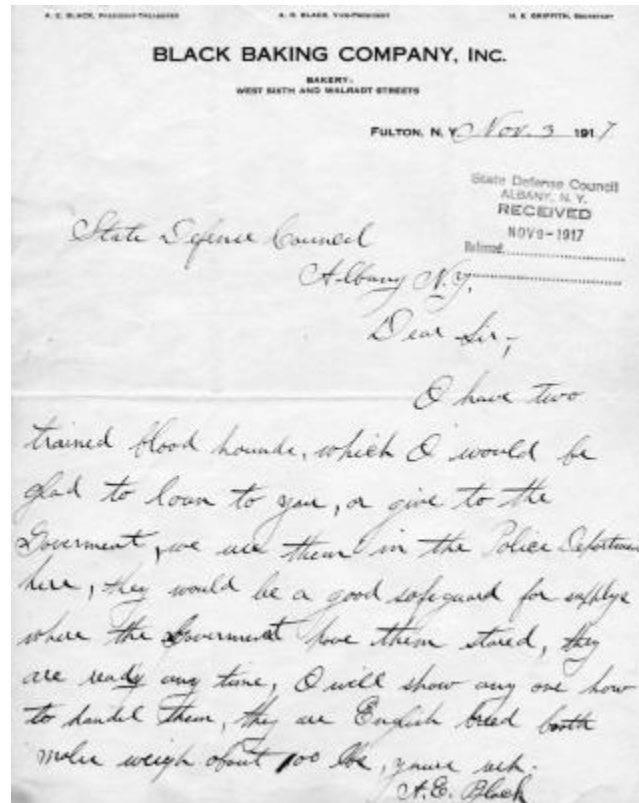


## Letter Offering Two Bloodhounds, 1917
