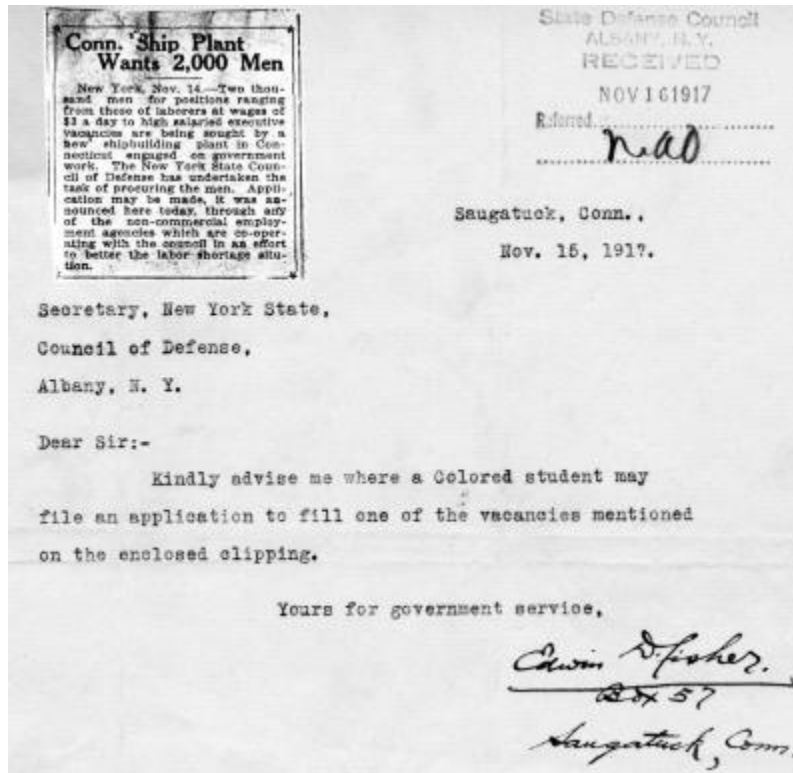


Man Looks for Work, 1917
