I am sorry I cannot be at the public meeting in Rochester on Oct. 17 so I am writing to ask that you make subdivision and development control in the Adirondacks a priority item on your agenda. Increasing density restrictions and requiring all projects including State projects to be compatible with the natural character of the park seem to me to be particularly important. Also, preserving shore line appearance by making the Adirondack Park Agency shoreline restrictions effective would be a step in the right direction, i.e. toward preserving the natural character of the park for future generations.
