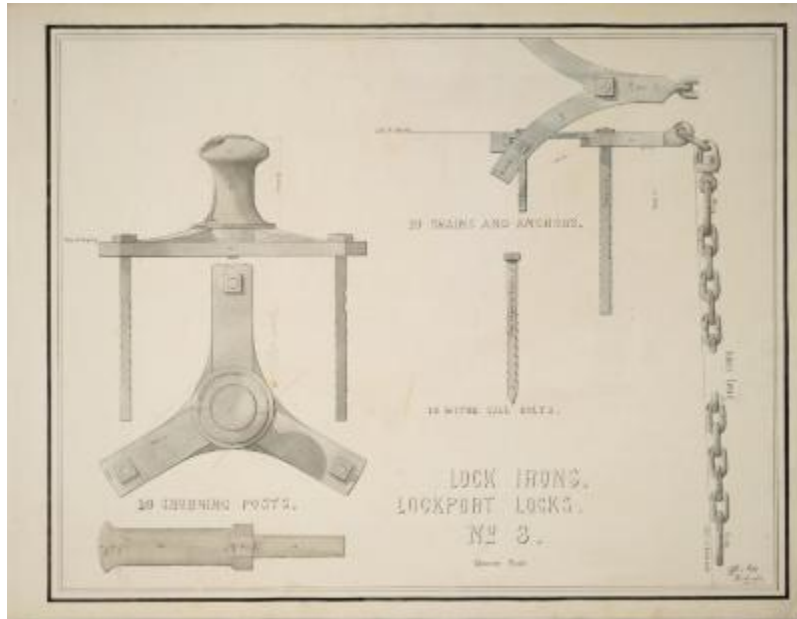


## Lock Irons. Lockport Irons. No. 3
