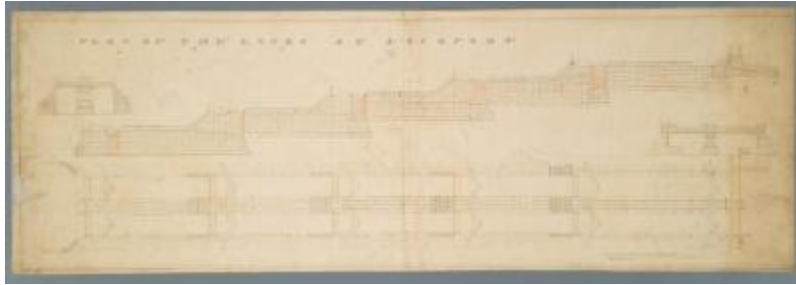


Plan of the Locks at Lockport



Drawing of locks built on the Erie Canal at Lockport, Niagara County. The locks are drawn in cross-section, seen from above, and seen from the front. The scale is one inch equals eleven feet. The date is unrecorded, but may be ca.1835-1862, during the first enlargement of the canal.
