Aerial photograph, no. 8 in a sequence, taken by plane flying northeast to southwest across lower Manhattan more than one month after the September 11 terrorist attack upon the World Trade Center, on October 21, 2001. By this point, most of the fires had been put out, and debris removal had begun.;The North Cove Marina, which was damaged on September 11, is visible at center left.
