Letter from Ann Leake to her stepsons informing them on how her health has improved, and instructing them to "remember me too in your prayers as I always do you." She told them how much she missed them, and indicated that she was unsure as to when they would see each other again. She also mentioned a gentlemen who was providing them with lodging in Newbury.
