

Statement of debts owed to John Leake, 1771

Whereas Jacob Concklin & Robert Bell in and by
their right, several Bonds or Obligations bearing date
respectively the day in the year of our Lord 1771
are and stand held firmly bound unto the said
John Leake in the several and respective Sums of
money hereinafter mentioned and payable in
the order hereinafter following to wit, one Bond
in the penalty of £ one hundred for the payment
of £ one or before the day of next ensuing
the date thereof, another Bond in the penalty
of £ one hundred for the payment of £ one or before
the day of next ensuing this year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred and seventy one
and therefore the Condition of the
above Obligations is such that if in the above
named Bonds hereinafter mentioned shall not
and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the
said John Leake his heirs Executors or Assigns
the several Sums of money in the said Bonds
mentioned at the respective times for that
purpose in the said Bonds limited without
any fraud or delay but according to the true
intent meaning of the said Bonds, then this
Obligation be void & ———
