Letter from Robert W. Leake to John Leake discussing his plans to build both a Grist Mill and a Dutch Mill in Pittstown, N.Y. Side two contains a reference by Robert Leake to the difficulty in receiving post from England, possibly as a result of pre-war escalation. Robert Leake stated "I long to hear from England and from you..."
