 An. Monday July 13<sup>th</sup> 1781  
 Resolved, if the Honorable the Senate concur herein, that it be recommended to the Commissioners of the Land Office for the western District to suspend the apprehension and conveyance of such forfeited Lands as have been sold by the said Commissioners, and the purchase monies for which have not been paid into the Treasury, until such time as the Legislature shall have determined upon the Petitions from the Purchasers for a farther day of payment, and that the Legislature will indemnify the said Commissioners for the same.  
 Ordered that Mr. Hardinier and Mr. M<sup>r</sup> Whicker carry a Copy of the above Resolution to the Honorable the Senate.
