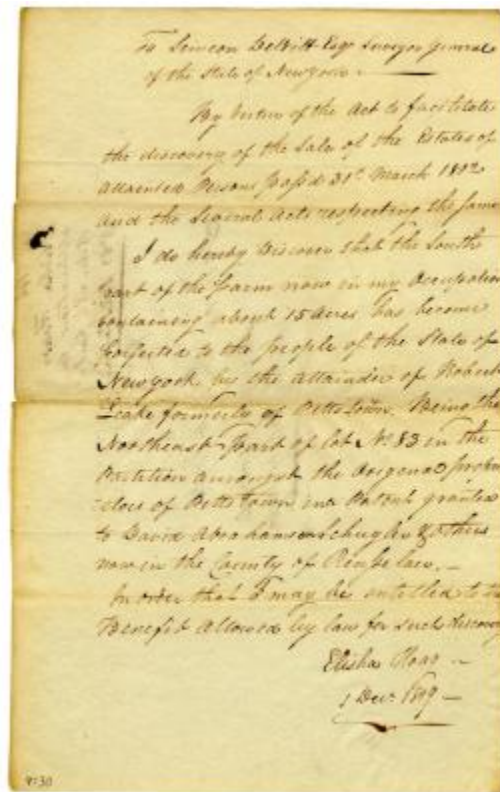


## Statement describing land forfeited in Rensselaer County, 1809
