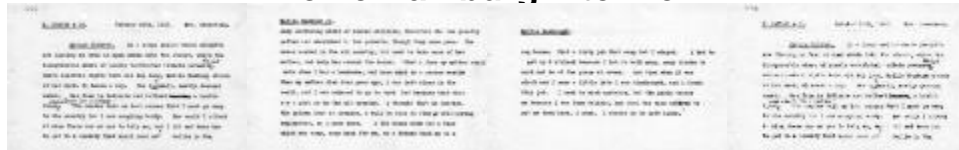


Mollie Hamburg Interview
