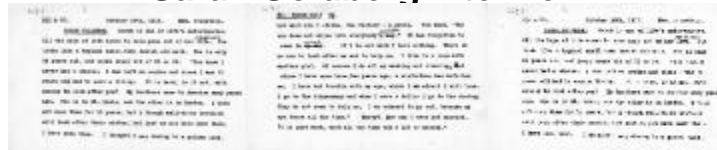


Sarah Goldberg Interview
