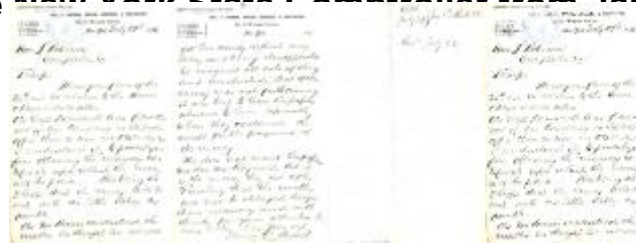


Letter to the New York State Comptroller from James E. Bedell
