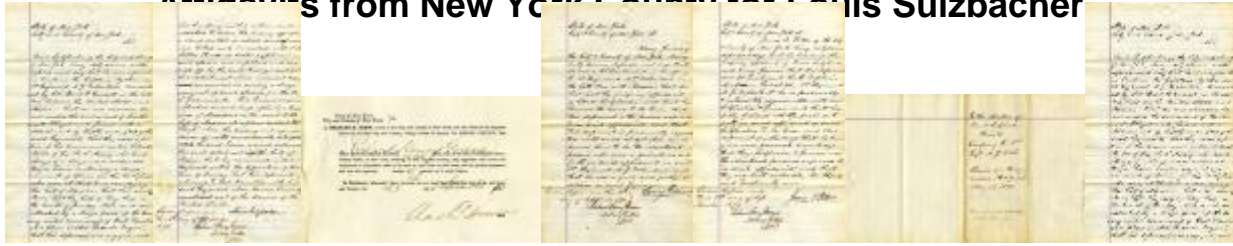


## Affidavits from New York County for Louis Sulzbacher



Three affidavits: the first signed by Louis Sulzbacher verifying his service in the First Regiment of New York Volunteers during the Mexican War; the second signed by Henry Gaines verifying the service of Louis Sulzbacher; the third signed by James D.
