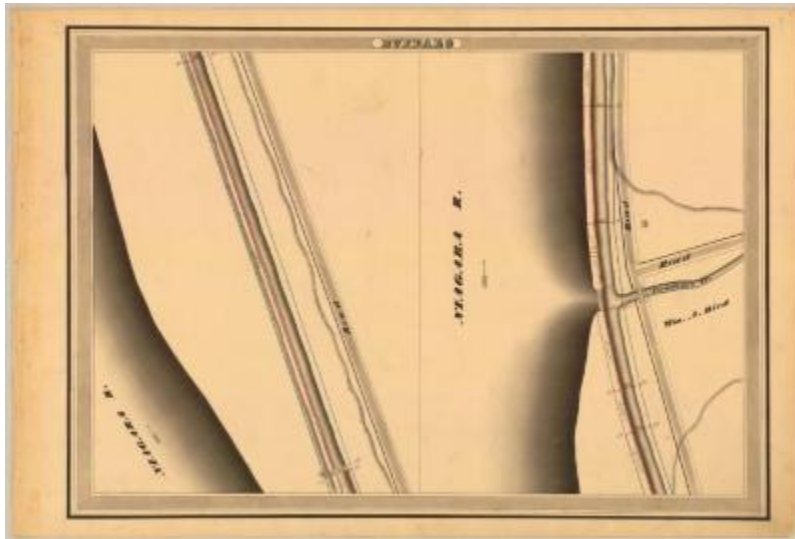


Erie Canal Survey, Buffalo showing two views of Niagara River
