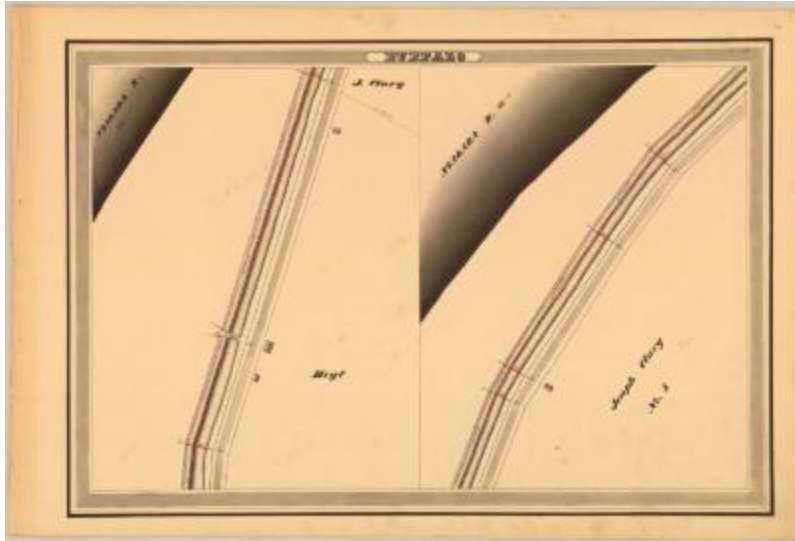


Erie Canal Survey, Buffalo showing Hoyt and Clary.
