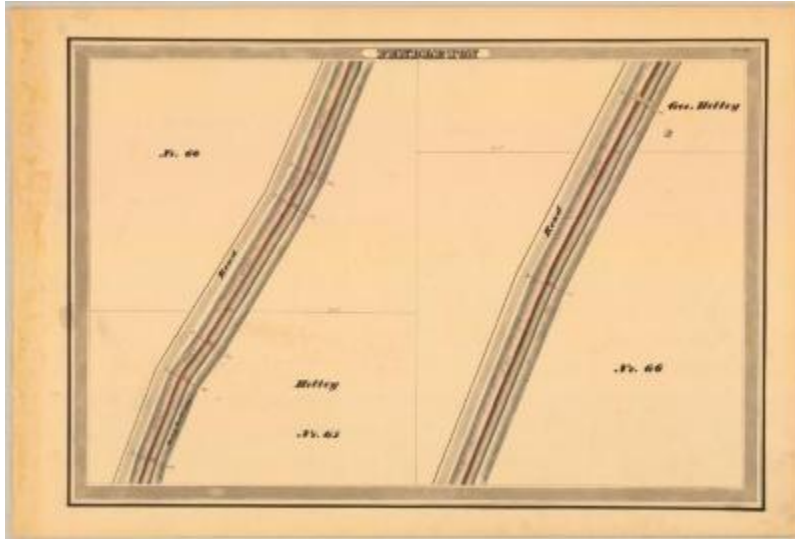


Erie Canal Survey, Pendleton showing Holley and Geo. Holley.
