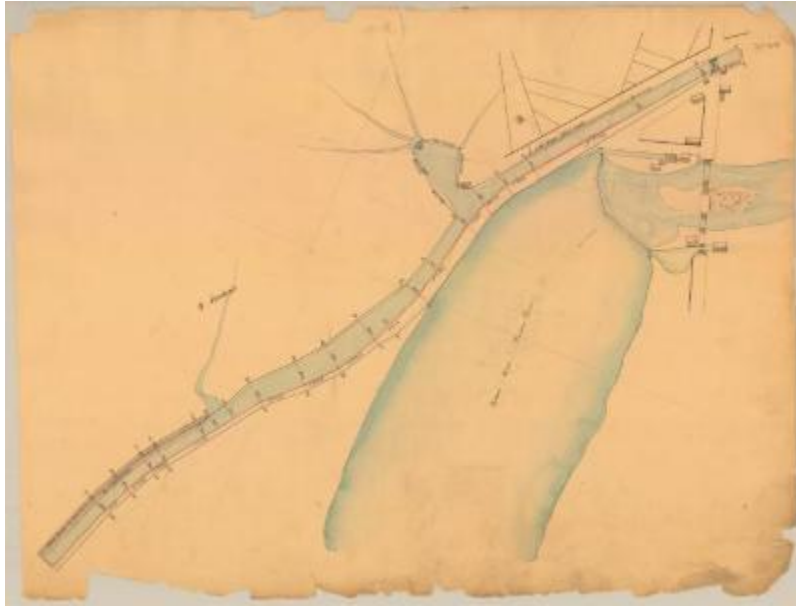


Erie and Champlain Canal Feeders, showing Heviland and Hudson River
