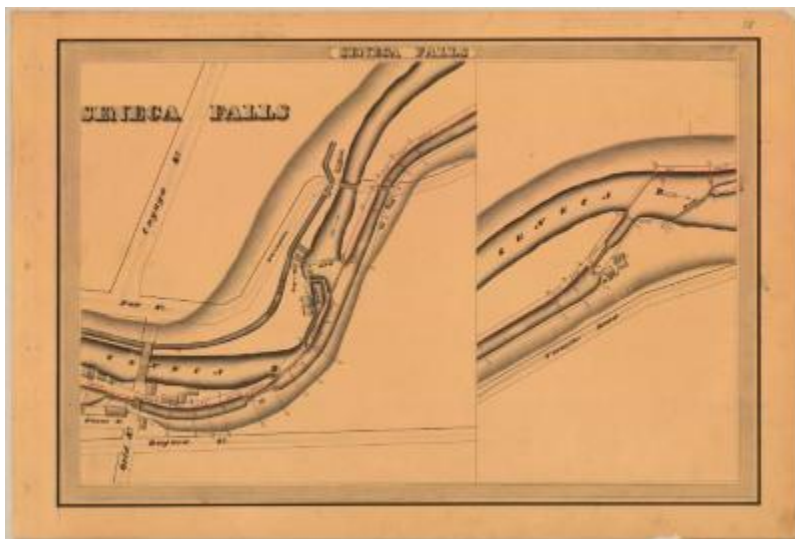


Cayuga and Seneca Canal Survey, Seneca Falls showing Mills, Dams, Bridges, Cayuga Street and Baynard Street
